

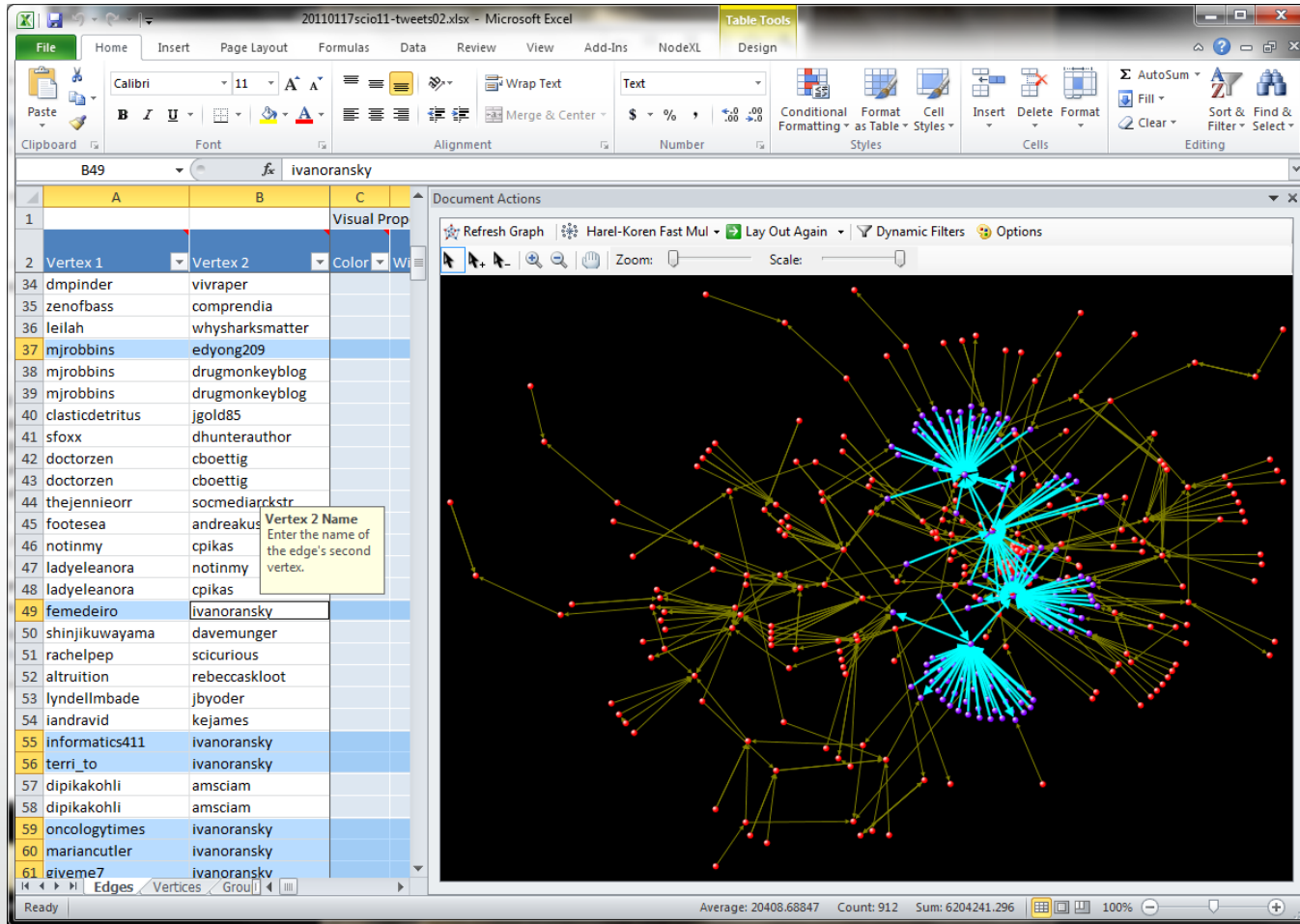

What is NodeXL

- Analyse and display networks of nodes and edges
- Free, open-source plug-in for Microsoft Excel
- Imports a variety of formats including CSV, GraphML
- Imports data from a variety of social networks
 - Twitter, Flickr, YouTube
- Various visualisation algorithms and network analysis functionality

- Navigate to: <http://nodexl.codeplex.com/> click the 'Downloads' link, download the latest version of NodeXL
- 2. Unzip the NodeXL download file, run 'Setup.exe' – make sure all office applications are closed.
