

Rapid review to use with poster draft

It can be used at any stage from storyboarding through to late draft one of the following ways

- Planning – before you start or when your ideas are well formed, estimate your competency/confidence
- During storyboarding – checking you are on track
- For a quick self-review during the development process – can be used iteratively
- As the basis for discussion during a content oriented peer review session, from early to late draft
- For self review at a story boarding stage you can record what you think you are likely to achieve and comment on the nature of your concerns
- Work through each criteria in turn, and score the factor on a 1-4 range, then provide a brief comment

1: Needs Improvement; 2 Satisfactory; 3 Very Satisfactory; 4 Outstanding
